

Eligibility Criteria for AMAS Mobility Master Students and Doctorate Candidates

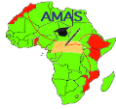
1. **Target I-** Master and PhD student already registered in one of the five (5) Partner Universities (this means registered in a home university which is one of these five universities that form the AMAS Project collaboration). These five Partner Universities are;
 - I. Moi University (MU), Kenya
 - II. Université Mohammed V de Rabat (UM5R), Morocco
 - III. Addis Ababa University (AAU), Ethiopia
 - IV. Université d'Abomey-Calavi (UAC), Benin
 - V. Universidade Eduardo Mondlane (UEM), Mozambique

Target I applicants **apply to any of the four universities** in the partnership, **BUT NOT** to their own home university (this means they will seek mobility in a different university from their own home university i.e., in a recipient/ host Partner University). For example, a student enrolled in a Master degree at Moi University applies for academic mobility in Addis Ababa University.

OR;

2. **Target II-** Master and PhD student registered in any recognizable university, outside the 5 Partner Universities. Preference is given to those applying from an African University that has a relationship with any of the five universities above.

Target II applicants **apply to any of the five universities** in the partnership, however, the university they apply to **MUST** be outside their home country. For example, a student enrolled in a PhD candidate enrolled in Haramaya University in Ethiopia applies for academic mobility in Université d'Abomey-Calavi (UAC), Benin.
3. **Master Student-** undertake studies for a **maximum of 6** months by academic mobility. Our high **preference is for academic mobility for Credit Seeking**
4. **Doctorate Candidate-** undertake studies for a **maximum of 6** months by academic mobility. Our high **preference is for academic mobility for Credit Seeking**
5. Both females and males are given equal eligibility statuses. The selection of candidates will ensure gender balance. Successful female candidates shall enjoy an added sponsorship benefit.

6. For both Master and Doctorate candidates, readiness to study the prescribed **CFS (Common Fields of Study) and SBP (Special Benefits Programmes)**, courses listed on *Doc T1-Table of Mobility Courses* as ascribed and offered at the recipient Partner University. **Successful candidates will only be admitted into the listed programmes/ courses**, which appropriately represent a common base of knowledge in the **AMSAS Project theme of “Social Sciences and Governance”**.

Applicants from disadvantaged backgrounds and populations are encouraged to apply.
